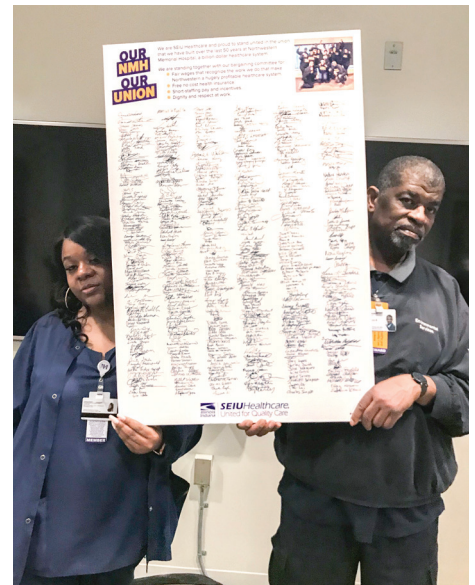
It seems like management doesn’t think we matter much at all, so it’s time to make it clear we know our lives, our safety, and our labor matters a lot.
