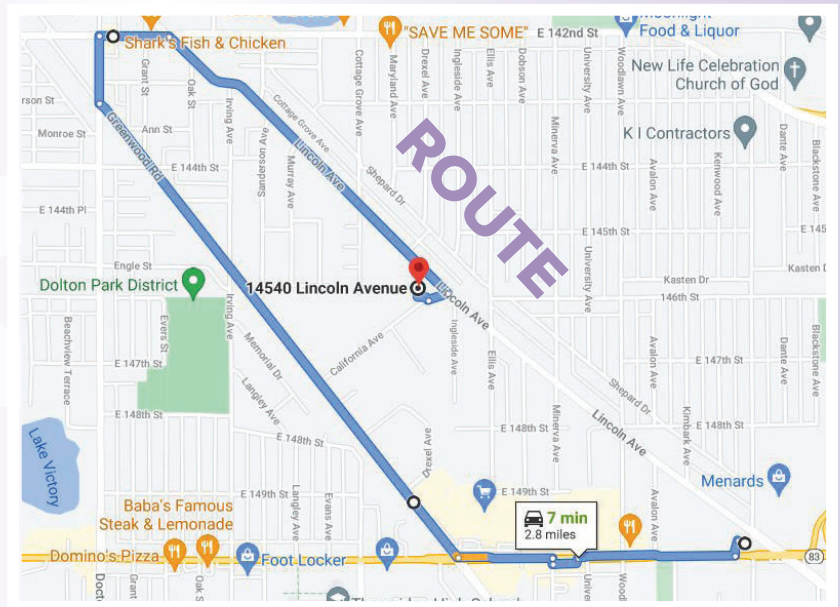

Supporting Ingalls Workers' Contract Fight

Ingalls workers have formed their union with SIEU. Essential workers deserve essential pay and a say at work. University of Chicago wants to pay workers “the Harvey Discount,” less than hospital workers at their Hyde Park location.

S 1 For the People Act

Sets national standards to ensure all eligible voters can vote. Includes automatic voter registration and vote by mail.

HR 4 John Lewis Voting Rights Act

Restores Voting Rights Act provisions struck down by the Supreme Court. Prevents states like

Georgia from passing laws that have a racially discriminatory impact.

HR 51 DC Statehood

Allows DC to become the 51st state. A plurality of its residents are Black, but they don't have federal representation.

Addressing the Filibuster

President Obama described it as a “Jim Crow relic.” It's a tool in the Senate used to block and delay civil rights, voting rights, and much progress.
